Ballet

Leotard & Tights Required
Canvas Ballet Shoes matching skin tone
Ballet skirts permitted
Hair **must** be secured & out of the face

Jazz

Leotard & Tights Required
Tan (Slip On) Jazz Shoes
Leggings/Shorts permitted
Hair **must** be secured & out of the face

Pre-K Combo

Leotard & Tights Required
Pink Canvas Ballet Shoes
Tap Shoes (with strap)
Ballet Skirts & Tutus Welcome!
Hair **must** be secured & out of the face

Hip-Hop

Comfortable Clothing Allowing Movement
Sneakers/Tennis Shoes

Contemporary

Comfortable Clothing Allowing Movement
Bare Feet or Socks

Tap

Fitted Clothing allowing movement
Tap Shoes
Tan-PreK, New Movers, Level 1; Black-Level 2 & up
Leggings/Shorts Permitted

Acrobatics

Fitted Clothing allowing movement
Bare Feet
Hair **must** be secured & out of the face

Additional Guidelines:

- Male Dancers:- Welcome to join any class within age level. (Ballet-black fitted pants/shorts, fitted white shirt, and black canvas ballet shoes; Other Styles-comfortable clothes allowing movement and appropriate shoes)
- Leotard & tights are required for all classes except Hip Hop, Contemporary, & Acrobatics
- **Tights should have convertible feet**
- Leotards of any style and color are permitted
- For Ballet & Pointe, tights and shoes should match skin tone
- Ballet skirts are welcome for Ballet & Pointe
- Leggings/Shorts/Fitted Pants permitted for all classes except Ballet & Pointe
- Hair must be secured & out of the face for **all classes** except Contemporary & Hip Hop
- Clothing with inappropriate images or verbiage will not be permitted
- Students are expected to wear coverups when entering and exiting the building
- Street shoes should not be worn in studio! Dance shoes should not be worn outside!
